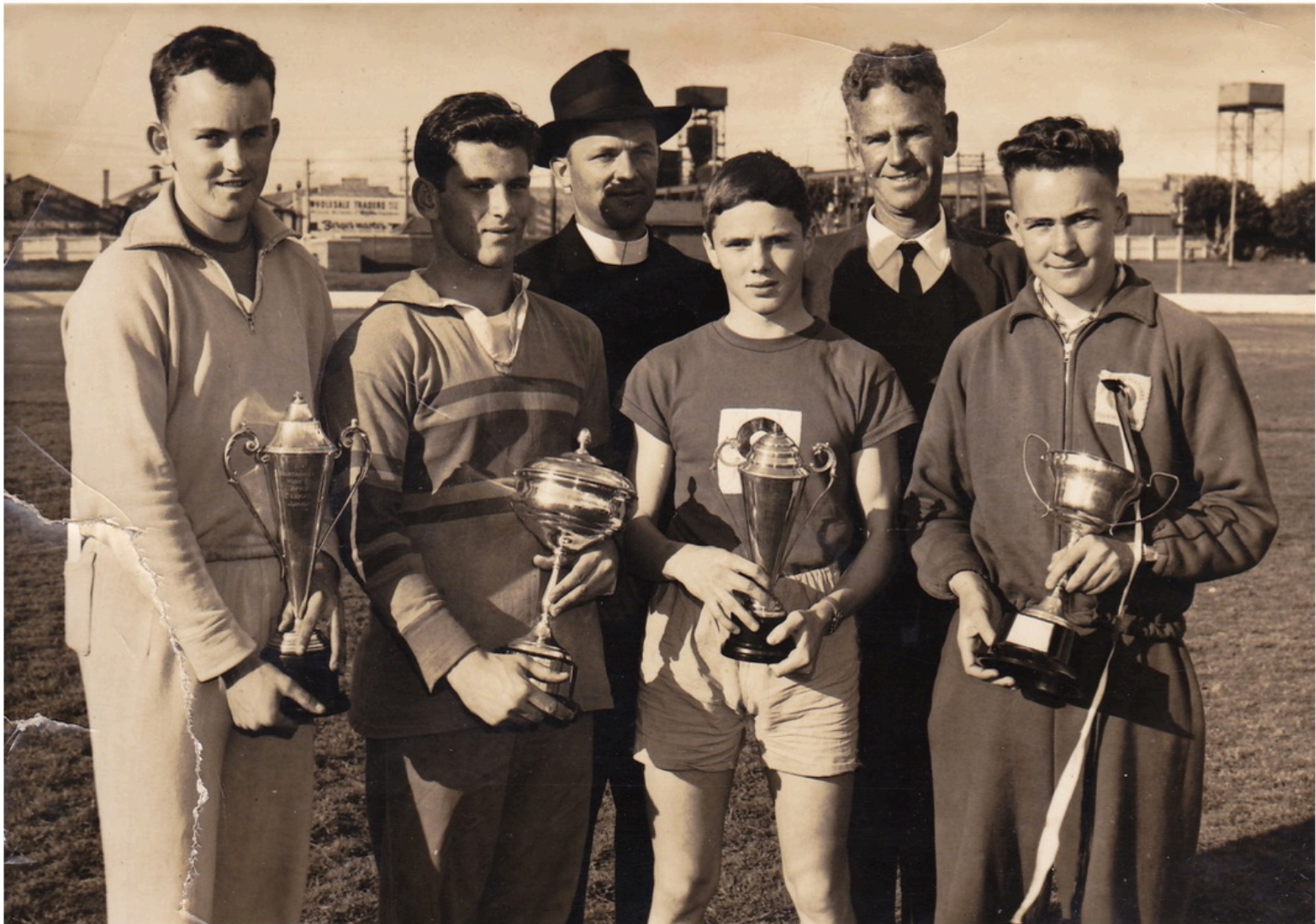


# Charlie Goffet School Memorabilia
