Newcastle High School came into existence in 1906 in three classrooms at 'The Hill' Primary School. Its initial enrolment was a small one of only 28 students. At the beginning of 1907 the enrolment had increased to 104. By 1912 the original 28 students had grown to over 300 and by 1930 the school had become so overcrowded that the girls moved to a new school in Hamilton South - Newcastle Girls' High. Newcastle Boys' High was then born. The boys remained at 'The Hill' until early in 1934, when they then moved to a new building at the school's present site of Waratah. The old 'Hill' school was taken over by Newcastle Junior High School.

In 1976 Newcastle Boys' High amalgamated with Wickham Girls' High, and following this an amalgamated name inevitably followed. The boys however, were hesitant to let their school stand without the proud tradition of the 'Boys' name being attached to the front. More than 90 year 12 boys staged a light hearted revolt at Waratah High to protest against the removal of the words 'Newcastle Boys' High School' from the wall. The 'Boys' old traditions were disappearing, but the sign was removed from the wall and replaced with its new name of Waratah High School.

Waratah High School upheld the fine traditions of both preceding schools to become a leading school both academically and in sport. Waratah was designated as a Technology High School in 1990, which catered for year 7-12 students. The year 2001 was the commencement of Callaghan College and is now a special learning environment for students in years 7-10.

As part of the celebration of 100 years of secondary education in Newcastle and 72 years of education on this site, Callaghan College Waratah Technology Campus is providing a series of events to mark these momentous occasions.
