And the bell goes for school in the morning.

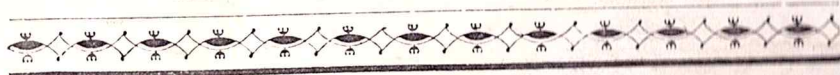
Yes, when we're gone, in the years far ahead,

Will still do their best night and morning.

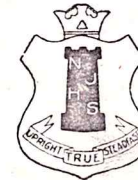
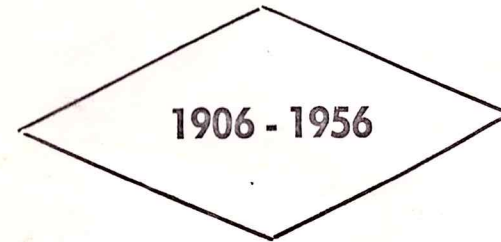
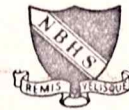
