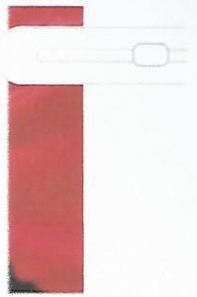

TRIBUTES have flowed for a good rugby man, accomplished cricketer, admired teacher and champion bloke after the death of Paul Burke.

Burke died at the Mater Hospice on Sunday after a long battle with illness.

He was aged 60.

A son of Wallabies great Cyril Burke, Paul carved out successful careers on the rugby park with The Waratahs and cricket field for Waratah-Mayfield. He also coached rugby at

Lake Macquarie.

At Waratah-Mayfield, as well as a distinguished player, he served two stints as club president and is a life member.

Burke was also a highly-respected teacher at St Paul's, Booragul and was heavily involved in junior sport.
