

Vale BRIAN MORLEY, 1929 -2025

My brother Brian passed away on 18th February 2025 aged 95 years.

We both were students at Newcastle Boys High School. He was eight years older than me, and was School Vice-Captain in 1946, and I understand, did continue on to become School Captain later that year.

He was awarded a Bursary Scholarship in his Third Year which enabled him to continue on for the final two school years.

He was a brilliant student with straight A's at the Leaving Certificate and excelled in Chemistry.

He won a University of Sydney Exhibition, a Commonwealth Scholarship as well as a Teacher Training Scholarship. He was a junior Lecturer at Sydney teachers College and went to Malaya to teach at Malay College, Kuala Kangsar for three years.

He was Science Subject Master at Cooma High School, and later a Lecturer at Alexander Mackie Teachers College.
